4. Title: Motor fuels tax; refund for taxicabs

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill clarifies the refund of fuels tax for taxicabs to include travel to medical facilities and public transportation facilities.

6. Fiscal impact estimates are indeterminate.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: Based on the expanded criteria for qualifying for a refund proposed by the bill, the number of taxicab services that will qualify for these refunds cannot be determined. Under the current criteria, refund amounts have been roughly \$360,000 each year for the past several years, with the same 40-50 taxicab services applying for the refunds each year. The Department of Motor Vehicles has issued permits to over 2,400 taxicab services in Virginia.
