4. Title Conveyance of real property to Southampton County

5. Summary/Purpose:

The proposed legislation would authorize the Department of Corrections (DOC) to convey, for a nominal consideration of \$1.00, approximately 47 acres to Southampton County for use as a work release center and for other jail purposes. This parcel is part of a larger tract owned by the state that contains the Southampton Correctional Center complex. The legislation requires the county to pay all costs and expenses incurred in the transfer of the property. It also makes the county responsible for the abatement, and related costs, of any existing environmental contamination to the extent required by law. Finally, the legislation requires that ownership of the property revert to the Commonwealth if the county were to transfer ownership of it to any other person in the future or cease to use it for jail purposes.
