**4. Title**            Pilot programs for drug and alcohol treatment in local and regional jails

**5. Summary/Purpose:** This bill allows for local and regional jails to develop drug and alcohol treatment programs for inmates housed within local and regional jails. The enrolled bill strikes the provision in the original bill that required the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services to develop a tracking mechanism and a plan for expanding use of these programs statewide, and to give technical assistance to local and regional jails.
