4. **Title** Alcoholic beverage control; government stores; sale of mixers

5. **Summary/Purpose:** This bill gives the Department of Alcoholic Beverages (ABC) the authority to sell products used in connection with distilled spirits, including any garnish or garnishment applied to the rim of a glass of distilled spirits as approved by the board in ABC stores. The proposal retains the authority of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to sell mixers at government stores.
