4. Title Sexually violent predators; Attorney General, et al to study feasibility of treatment options, etc.

Summary/Purpose: The bill provides that the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services and the Attorney General's Office shall examine, as possible components of conditional release of civilly committed sexual violent predators, the feasibility of the use of physical castration as a treatment option and the use of residential housing facilities, operated by the Commonwealth or by private providers contracted with the Commonwealth on property owned by the Commonwealth, and shall report the results of the examination to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 1, 2008.
