**5. Summary/Purpose:** Provides that any business or organization required to conduct a national criminal background check also must bear the costs, unless it recoups such costs from the applicant. Assesses a civil penalty of up to \$500 for knowing, willful failure to comply with background check requirements and may impose additional statutory measures to revoke the licensure of facilities or other entities.
