8.	Fiscal implications: The legislation would allow Augusta County to charge not more than \$150 to persons seeking an onsite sewage disposal system permit. The fiscal impact of this legislation cannot be determined because the application processing fee cannot exceed \$150 per application and the number of applicants is unknown.	
9.	Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Virginia Department of Health	
10	0. Technical amendment necessary: Yes. The legislation states that counties may prescribe a reasonable fee not exceeding \$150 for processing onsite sewage disposal system applications. The bill should clearly indicate that only Augusta County should be able to prescribe a reasonable application fee.
