3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Permit for onsite sewage disposal system installation in certain counties

5. Summary/Purpose: The legislation provides that Augusta County may require any person desiring to install an onsite sewage disposal system to secure a permit to do so. The county may prescribe a reasonable fee, not to exceed \$150, for processing an application for such a permit.

6. Fiscal Impact is Indeterminate: See item #8.

7. Budget amendment necessary: No.

8. Fiscal implications: The legislation would allow Augusta County to charge not more than \$150 to persons seeking an onsite sewage disposal system permit. The fiscal impact of this legislation cannot be determined because the application processing fee cannot exceed \$150 per application and the number of applicants is unknown.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: Virginia Department of Health

10. Technical amendment necessary: Yes. The legislation states that counties may prescribe a reasonable fee not exceeding \$150 for processing onsite sewage disposal system applications. The bill should clearly indicate that only Augusta County should be able to prescribe a reasonable application fee.
