4. Title Sex offender registry notification - nursing homes and assisted living facilities

5. Summary/Purpose: The bill requires nursing homes and assisted living facilities to register with the Department of State Police to receive notice of the registration or reregistration of any sex offender within the same contiguous zip code of the facility. In addition, each facility must also ascertain prior to admission whether a potential patient is a registered sex offender.

6. No Fiscal Impact

8. Fiscal implications: None. The bill adds a requirement for nursing homes and assisted living facilities to register with the State Police to receive notices regarding registered sex offenders. The notification system is fully automated and will send notices electronically and thus imposes no cost on the state.
