**4. Title** Fee for testimonials; repeat authentications.

**5. Summary/Purpose:** The bill sets the fee to be charged by the Secretary of the Commonwealth at five dollars, including seal tax, for each authentication after the first testimonial for documents bearing the testament by the same person on the same date.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates are:** Indeterminate.

**7. Budget amendment necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal implications:** Since the cost for repeat authentications would be reduced from \$10 to five dollars, the bill is likely to reduce the general fund revenue collected by the Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth (SOC). It is impossible to determine the amount of loss to the general fund as the SOC does not track how often a given customer orders repeat authentications.

**9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected:** The Secretary of the Commonwealth.
