4. Title Physical examination of prisoners

5. Summary/Purpose:

The enrolled bill would require the Department of Corrections (DOC) to have an inmate examined by a licensed physician within 30 days prior to any work assignment in food services, medical services, or cosmetological services or a change in work assignment. The bill would authorize a prison warden to exclude inmates, on a case-by-case basis, from work assignments based upon the classification of the institution and the safety and good order of the facility.

8. Fiscal implications:

The Department of Corrections currently performs a physical exam on all inmates prior to their being assigned to food services, medical services, or cosmetological services. Consequently, the bill will have no fiscal impact on DOC.
