4. Title Security of confidential state data.

5. Summary/Purpose: Requires the Chief Information Officer of the Commonwealth to develop policies, procedures, and standards relating to the security data maintained and used by state agencies. The policies, procedures, and standards must include requirements that a user be required to provide a password or other means of authentication to access a computer and to access a state-owned or operated computer network or database through the computer, and that a digital rights management system or other means of authenticating be used to control access to electronic records containing confidential information.
