CHAPTER 503

An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-930 of the Code of Virginia, relating to loitering in the rights-of-way of certain highways.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 46.2-930 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-930. Loitering on bridges or highway rights-of-way.

Pedestrians shall not loiter on any bridge *or in any portion of the right-of-way of any highway where loitering has been determined by the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner or the local governing body of any city or town to present a public safety hazard and on which the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner or the governing body of any city or town has posted signs prohibiting* such action. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a traffic infraction.
