	§ 2.2-3707.01. Meetings of the General Assembly.
13 14	A. Except as provided in subsection B, public access to any meeting of the General Assembly or a portion thereof shall be governed by rules established by the Joint Rules Committee and approved by a
14	majority vote of each house at the next regular session of the General Assembly. At least 60 days before
16	the adoption of such rules, the Joint Rules Committee shall (i) hold regional public hearings on such
17	proposed rules and (ii) provide a copy of such proposed rules to the Virginia Freedom of Information
18	Advisory Council.
19	B. Floor sessions of either house of the General Assembly; meetings, including work sessions, of any
20	standing or interim study committee of the General Assembly; meetings, including work sessions, of any
21	subcommittee of such standing or interim study committee; and joint committees of conference of the
22	General Assembly; or a quorum of any such committees or subcommittees, shall be open and governed
23	by this chapter. However, notwithstanding subsection B of § 2.2-3708, a quorum of an interim study
24	committee of the General Assembly need not be assembled in one physical location to conduct a meeting
25	using electronic communications.
26	Č. Meetings of the respective political party caucuses of either house of the General Assembly,
27	including meetings conducted by telephonic or other electronic communication means, without regard to
