## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

An Act to amend and reenact § 23-9.2:3 of the Code of Virginia, relating to release of educational 2 3 records.

[H 1058]

## Approved

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That § 23-9.2:3 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

9 § 23-9.2:3. Power of governing body of educational institution to establish rules and regulations; 10 offenses occurring on property of institution; state direct student financial assistance; release of educational records. 11

12 A. In addition to the powers now enjoyed by it, the board of visitors or other governing body of 13 every educational institution shall have the power:

1. To establish rules and regulations for the acceptance and assistance of students except that (i) 14 individuals who have failed to meet the federal requirement to register for the selective service shall not 15 be eligible to receive any state direct student assistance; (ii) the accreditation status of a Virginia public 16 high school shall not be considered in making admissions determinations for students who have earned a 17 diploma pursuant to the requirements established by the Board of Education; and (iii) the governing 18 boards of the four-year institutions shall establish policies providing for the admission of certain 19 20 graduates of Virginia community colleges as set forth in § 23-9.2:3.02. 21

2. To establish rules and regulations for the conduct of students while attending such institution.

22 3. To establish programs, in cooperation with the State Council of Higher Education and the Office of the Attorney General, to promote compliance among students with the Commonwealth's laws relating 23 24 to the use of alcoholic beverages.

25 4. To establish rules and regulations for the rescission or restriction of financial aid, within the 26 discretionary authority provided to the institution by federal or state law and regulations, and the 27 suspension and dismissal of students who fail or refuse to abide by such rules and regulations for the 28 conduct of students.

29 5. To establish rules and regulations for the employment of professors, teachers, instructors and all 30 other employees and provide for their dismissal for failure to abide by such rules and regulations.

31 6. To provide parking and traffic rules and regulations on property owned by such institution.

32 7. To establish guidelines for the initiation or induction into any social fraternity or sorority in 33 accordance with § 18.2-56.

34 8. To establish programs, in cooperation with the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia and 35 the Office of the Attorney General, to promote the awareness and prevention of sexual crimes 36 committed upon students.

37 B. Upon receipt of an appropriate resolution of the board of visitors or other governing body of an 38 educational institution, the governing body of a political subdivision which is contiguous to the 39 institution shall enforce state statutes and local ordinances with respect to offenses occurring on the 40 property of the institution.

41 The governing bodies of the public institutions of higher education shall assist the State Council of 42 Higher Education in enforcing the provisions related to eligibility for financial aid.

43 C. The board of visitors or other governing body of every public institution of higher education in 44 Virginia shall establish policies and procedures requiring the release of the educational record of a dependent student, as defined by 20 U.S.C. § 1232g, to a parent at his request. 45

C D. In order to improve the quality of the Commonwealth's work force and educational programs, 46 the governing bodies of the public institutions of higher education shall establish programs to seek to 47 ensure that all graduates have the technology skills necessary to compete in the 21st Century and, **48** 49 particularly, that all students matriculating in teacher-training programs receive instruction in the 50 effective use of educational technology.
