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| 10 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 11 12 | 1. That §§ 5.1-23 and 52-8 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: |
| | § 5.1-23. Jurisdiction of local and State Police. |
| 13 14 | The local police authorities of any city, incorporated town or county shall have jurisdiction on the |
| 14 | premises of any airport, drop zone or landing field operated hereunder, either individually or jointly, and the State Police <i>and the local police authority of any city or county in which an aircraft accident occurs</i> |
| 15 16 | shall have jurisdiction to investigate any aircraft such accident. In the exercise of such jurisdiction the |
| 17 | State Police and officers of the department of law enforcement of any city or county with an optional |
| 18 | form of government may enter with immunity and without a warrant upon private property for the |
| 19 | purpose of conducting such investigations. This section shall not repeal the provisions of any city charter |
| 20 | in conflict herewith. |
| 2 1 | § 52-8. Powers and duties to enforce criminal laws. |
| 22 | The Superintendent of State Police, his several assistants and police officers appointed by him are |
| 23 | vested with the powers of a sheriff for the purpose of enforcing all the criminal laws of this |
| 24 | Commonwealth and for investigating any aircraft accident which occurs in the Commonwealth, and it |
| 25 | shall be the duty of the Superintendent, his several assistants and police officers appointed by him to use |
| 26 | their best efforts to enforce the same. |
| 27 | Nothing in this section shall be construed as relieving any sheriff or sergeant, commissioner of the |
| 28 | revenue, police officer, or any other official now or hereafter invested with police powers and duties, |
| 29 | state or local, from the duty of aiding and assisting in the enforcement of such laws within the scope of |
| 30 | his authority and duty. |
