Patron Prior to Engrossment-Delegate Lingamfelter 8 Referred to Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources 9 10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 29.1-300.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of 11 Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 29.1-300.4 as follows: 12 13 § 29.1-300.1. Certification of competence in hunter education. 14 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and § 29.1-300.4, no hunting license shall be 15 issued to (i) a person who has never obtained a license to hunt in any state or country, or (ii) a person who is under the age of sixteen, unless such a person presents to the Board of Game and Inland 16 17 Fisheries or one of its authorized license vendors, a certificate of completion in hunter education issued or authorized by the Board under the hunter education program, or proof that he holds the equivalent 18 19 certificate obtained from an authorized agency or association of another state or country. 20 B. Although a resident under the age of twelve is not required to obtain a license to hunt, any person 21 under the age of twelve, or an individual on his behalf, may purchase a Virginia hunting license or a 22 junior lifetime hunting license pursuant to § 29.1-302.1, without completing a hunter education program 23 as required in subsection A of this section, provided that no person under the age of twelve shall hunt 24 unless accompanied and directly supervised by an adult who has, on his person, a valid Virginia hunting 25 license. The junior lifetime hunting license issued to an individual under the age of twelve shall become invalid on the individual's twelfth birthday and remain invalid until certification of competence in hunter 26 27 education is shown as provided in this section. A lifetime license, indicating the completion of hunter 28 education or an equivalent certificate, shall be reissued at no cost when such proof is provided. 29 The adult shall be responsible for such supervision. For the purposes of this section, "adult" means 30 the parent or legal guardian of the person under age twelve, or such person over the age of eighteen 31 designated by the parent or legal guardian. "Accompanied and directly supervised" means that the adult is within sight of the person under the 32 33 age of twelve. 34 C. This section shall not apply to persons while on horseback hunting foxes with hounds but without 35 firearms. 36 § 29.1-300.4. Apprentice hunting license; deferral of hunter education. 37 A. There is hereby established an apprentice hunting license. The license shall be a one-time 38 nonrenewable license that shall be valid for [ one year two years ] from the date of purchase and shall 39 entitle the licensee to a one-time deferral of completion of hunter education required under § 29.1-300.1. 40 The apprentice hunting licensee shall not hunt unless accompanied and directly supervised by an adult 41 over the age of 18 who has, on his person, a valid Virginia hunting license. For the purposes of this section, "accompanied and directly supervised" occurs when a person over 18 maintains a close visual 42 and verbal contact with, provides adequate direction to, and can immediately assume control of the 43 firearm from the apprentice hunter. The cost of the license shall be \$10 for a resident and \$20 for a 44 45 nonresident. B. Possession of a valid apprentice hunting license shall serve in lieu of the state resident hunting or 46 47 nonresident hunting license required under subdivision 2 and 3 of § 29.1-303, respectively. The purchase of any other hunting licenses shall be at the same cost as specified for residents or **48** nonresidents in this title or as subsequently revised by the Board pursuant to subdivision 16 of 49 § 29.1-103. The purchase of the apprentice hunting license shall not qualify the holder to purchase a 50 51 regular hunting license or exempt the licensee from compliance with the requirements of this title and any regulations adopted by the Department. Any previous holder of a state resident or nonresident 52 53 hunting license issued under this title shall be prohibited from the purchase of an apprentice hunting 54 license for himself. C. The Board may adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of this section. 55
