2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 15.2-2503 and 22.1-93 of the Code of Virginia, relating to publication 3 of local government and school board budgets online.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That §§ 15.2-2503 and 22.1-93 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 15.2-2503. Time for preparation and approval of budget; contents.

9 All officers and heads of departments, offices, divisions, boards, commissions, and agencies of every 10 locality shall, on or before the first day of April of each year, prepare and submit to the governing body an estimate of the amount of money needed during the ensuing fiscal year for his department, office, 11 12 division, board, commission or agency. If such person does not submit an estimate in accordance with 13 this section, the clerk of the governing body or other designated person or persons shall prepare and 14 submit an estimate for that department, office, division, board, commission or agency.

15 The governing body shall prepare and approve a budget for informative and fiscal planning purposes only, containing a complete itemized and classified plan of all contemplated expenditures and all 16 estimated revenues and borrowings for the locality for the ensuing fiscal year. The governing body shall 17 approve the budget and fix a tax rate for the budget year no later than the date on which the fiscal year 18 19 begins. The governing body shall annually publish the approved budget on the locality's website, if any, 20 or shall otherwise make the approved budget available in hard copy as needed to citizens for inspection. 21 § 22.1-93. Approval of annual budget for school purposes.

22 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including but not limited to Chapter 25 (§ 15.2-2500 et 23 seq.) of Title 15.2, the governing body of a county shall prepare and approve an annual budget for 24 educational purposes by May first or within thirty days of the receipt by the county of the estimates of 25 state funds, whichever shall later occur, and the governing body of a municipality shall prepare and approve an annual budget for educational purposes by May fifteen or within thirty days of the receipt by 26 27 the municipality of the estimates of state funds, whichever shall later occur. Upon approval, each local school division shall publish the approved annual budget on the division's website, if any, or if there is 28 29 no division website, the document shall otherwise be made available in hard copy as needed to citizens 30 for inspection.

31 The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall, no later than the fifteenth day following final 32 adjournment of the Virginia General Assembly in each session, submit estimates to be used for 33 budgetary purposes relative to the Basic School Aid Formula to each school division and to the local 34 governing body of each county, city and town that operates a separate school division. Such estimates 35 shall be for each year of the next biennium or for the then next fiscal year.

2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on January 1, 2009. 36
