6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 10.1-109 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 10.1-109. Conveyance or lease of lands and other properties.

9 A. The Director is authorized, subject to the consent and approval of the Governor and the General
10 Assembly, following review as to form and content by the Attorney General and the provisions of this
11 article, to convey, lease or demise to any person for consideration, by proper deed or other appropriate
12 instrument signed and executed by the Director, in the name of the Commonwealth: (i) any lands or
13 other properties held for general recreational or other public purposes by the Department, for the
14 Commonwealth; (ii) any lands over which the Department has supervision and control, or any part of
15 such lands; or (iii) any right, interest or privilege with respect to such lands. The Director, subject to the
16 consent and approval of the Governor, may renew any such lease, contract or agreement without the
17 consent and approval of the General Assembly. Whenever land is acquired by purchase or otherwise for
18 public recreation and conservation purposes under the administration of the Department, the Director is
19 authorized to lease the land or any portion of it to the owner from whom the land is acquired upon
20 terms and conditions in the public interest. No lease granted under this section shall be for an initial
21 term longer than ten years, but any such lease may contain provisions for lease renewals, either
22 contingent or automatic at the discretion of the Director, for a like period upon the same terms and
23 conditions as originally granted. If written notice of termination is received by the Director from the
24 lessee or if use of the lease is in fact abandoned by the lessee at any time prior to the end of the initial
25 term or any renewal, the Director may immediately terminate the lease.

26 B. The Director is authorized to lease state-owned housing under the control of the Department to
27 state employees. Such leases shall be approved as to form and content by the Attorney General and the
28 Department of General Services. The leasing of Department-controlled housing to state employees shall
29 be for the purposes of providing security *and operational efficiencies* to property of the Department and
30 shall not cause the property to be considered surplus to the agency's need. *If the Director determines*
31 *that the availability of state-owned housing is inadequate to meet the onsite security and operational*
32 *efficiencies requirements for Department-owned property, he may lease residential property not owned*
33 *by the Commonwealth from prospective landlords for the purposes of subleasing to state employees who*
34 *otherwise qualify for leasing state-owned housing. Such leases and subleases shall be approved by the*
35 *Director.*
