10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That §§ 18.2-308.1:3 and 37.2-819 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as
11	follows:
13	§ 18.2-308.1:3. Purchase, possession or transportation of firearm by persons involuntarily admitted or
14	ordered to outpatient treatment; penalty.
15	A. It shall be unlawful for any person involuntarily committed admitted to a facility or ordered to
16	involuntary outpatient treatment pursuant to Article 5 (§ 37.2-814 et seq.) of Chapter 8 of Title 37.2 to
17	purchase, possess or transport a firearm during the period of such person's commitment. A violation of
18	this subsection shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.
19	B. Any person prohibited from purchasing, possessing or transporting firearms under this section
20	may, at any time following his release from commitment an involuntary admission to a facility or
21	involuntary outpatient treatment, petition the circuit court in the city or county in which he resides to
22	restore his right to purchase, possess or transport a firearm. The court may, in its discretion and for
23	good cause shown, grant the petition. The clerk shall certify and forward forthwith to the Central
24	Criminal Records Exchange, on a form provided by the Exchange, a copy of any such order.

26 27	firearm background check. The Immediately upon entry of any order issued pursuant to this chapter for involuntary admission
