8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § [46.2-925] of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 46.2-925. Pedestrian control signals.
11	Whenever special pedestrian control signals exhibiting the words, numbers, or symbols meaning
12	"Walk" or "Don't Walk" are in place such signals shall indicate and apply to pedestrians as follows:
13	Walk Pedestrians facing such signal may proceed across the highway in the direction of the signal
14 15	and shall be given the right-of-way by the drivers of all vehicles.
15	Don't Walk No pedestrian shall start to cross the highway in the direction of such signal, but any

15 Don't Walk. - No pedestrian shall start to cross the highway in the direction of such signal, but any 16 pedestrian who has partially completed his crossing on the Walk signal shall proceed to a sidewalk or 17 safety island and remain there while the Don't Walk signal is showing.
