Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Commonwealth shall not conduct any executions of prisoners sentenced to death. This act is a suspension of executions only; all other matters of law 10 11 related to the death penalty, including but not limited to bringing and trying capital charges, sentencing 12 proceedings, imposing a death sentence, appeals and habeas review, are not affected by this act. 13 2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on July 1, 2013. 14 **15** 3. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is 16 17 \$554,589 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice. 18
