10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 24.2-625.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 24.2-625.2. Wireless communications at polling places.
13	There shall be no wireless communications on election day, while the polls are open, between or
14	among voting machines within the polling place or between any voting machine within the polling place
15	and any equipment outside the polling place. However, wireless communications are permitted after the
16	polls have closed between voting machines in the polling place and for the transmittal of data by
17	modem to the local electoral board office. For purposes of this section, the term wireless communication
18	shall mean the ability to transfer information via electromagnetic waves without the use of electrical
