6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 46.2-930 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-930. Loitering on bridges or highway rights-of-way.

9 Pedestrians shall not loiter on any bridge *or in any portion of the right-of-way of any highway where*  
10 *loitering has been determined by the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner or the local*  
11 *governing body of any city or town to present a public safety hazard and on which the Commonwealth*  
12 *Transportation Commissioner or the governing body of any city or town has posted signs prohibiting*  
13 *such action. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a traffic infraction.*
