11	1. That § 18.2-174 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-174. Impersonating officer.
13	Any person who shall falsely assume or exercise the functions, powers, duties and privileges incident
14	to the office of sheriff, police officer, marshal, or other peace officer, or who shall falsely assume or
15	pretend to be any such officer, shall be deemed is guilty of a Class 4 misdemeanor6 felony.
16	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
17	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is
18	\$465,935 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be
