Oath of parties before clerk and issuance of certificates thereof. 11 12 The clerk issuing any marriage license shall before issuing the license require the parties 13 contemplating marriage to state, under oath, or by affidavit or affidavits filed with him, made by the parties for whom the application is made, before a person qualified to take acknowledgments or 14 administer oaths, the information required to complete the marriage record, including the social security 15 number of each party if such number has been issued to the party by the Social Security Administration. 16 17 Such clerk shall make two certificates thereof and deliver them, together with the license, to the person entitled thereto. For the purposes of this section any statement made by such applicant, under oath, 18

19 concerning the information to be entered on the record is hereby declared to be a material matter or 20 thing in any prosecution for perjury for any violation of this section.
