Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

7 1. That § 9.1-185.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 9.1-185.4. Limitations on licensure.

9 A. In order to be licensed as a bail bondsman a person shall (i) be 18 years of age or older, (ii) have 10 received a high school diploma or GED, and (iii) have successfully completed the bail bondsman exam required by the Board or successfully completed prior to July 1, 2005, a surety bail bondsman exam 11 required by the State Corporation Commission under former § 38.2-1865.7. 12

B. The following persons are not eligible for licensure as bail bondsmen and may not be employed 13 14 nor serve as the agent of a bail bondsman:

15 1. Persons who have been convicted of a felony within the Commonwealth, any other state, or the 16 United States, who have not been pardoned, or whose civil rights have not been restored;

2. Employees of a local or regional jail; 17

- 18 3. Employees of a sheriff's office;
 - 4. Employees of a state or local police department;

20 5. Persons appointed as conservators of the peace pursuant to Article 4.1 (§ 9.1-150.1 et seq.) of this 21 chapter; 22

6. Employees of an office of an attorney for the Commonwealth;

23 7. Employees of the Department of Corrections, Department of Criminal Justice Services, or a local 24 pretrial or community-based probation services agency; and

25 8. Spouses of or any persons residing in the same household as persons referred to in subdivisions 2 26 through 7 of this section who are sworn officers or whose responsibilities involve direct access to 27 records of inmates.

28 C. The exclusions in subsection B shall not be construed to limit the ability of a licensed bail 29 bondsman to employ or contract with a licensed bail enforcement agent authorized to do business in the 30 Commonwealth.
