15	A. To the extent authorized by federal law, the Department shall spend a minimum of one percent of
16	all funds received through the federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant during each
17	fiscal year to fund programs that support the development of healthy marriages and the strengthening of
18	families.
19	B. A portion, not to exceed 10 percent, of the money required to be spent as provided in subsection
20	A shall be allocated to develop a process, in cooperation with any public college or university, for
21	identifying best practices and outcomes for programs supported by grants made pursuant to this section.
22	C. If before implementation of any provision of this section a state agency determines that a waiver
23	or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency
24	affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that
25	provision until the waiver or authorization is granted.
