8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37	WHEREAS, political boundaries sometimes serve as barriers to the most effective response to emergency situations; and WHEREAS, better coordination among localities of the Hampton Roads region may serve to provide a better emergency response; and WHEREAS, such an improvement in regional emergency response will require an in-depth examination of the current procedures and resources of the localities of Hampton Roads; and WHEREAS, other issues, including the possible need for enabling legislation, also need to be examined; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission be requested to study automatic aide for emergency responses across jurisdictional lines. In conducting its study, the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission shall review the emergency responses of the localities of the Hampton Roads region, including responses across jurisdictional lines. The commission shall take an in-depth look at what would be necessary to facilitate dispatchers' ability to see across jurisdictional lines and to know what responders may be available in neighboring localities. The Commission shall also examine any other issues relevant to accomplish the purposes of the study, including the need for any additional enabling legislation and shall issue all appropriate recommendations.
