WHEREAS, while in Washington, D.C., Nick Manning will visit the White House and meet with senators and representatives to talk about the important work done at children's hospitals around the country; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby commend and congratulate Nick Manning on being named Virginia's 2008 Children's Miracle Network champion; and, be it
