11	each house agreeing. That the following amendment to the Constitution of Virginia be, and the same
12	hereby is, proposed and referred to the General Assembly at its first regular session held after the next
13	general election of members of the House of Delegates for its concurrence in conformity with the
14 15	provisions of Section 1 of Article XII of the Constitution of Virginia, namely: Amend Article X of the Constitution of Virginia by adding a section numbered 6-A as follows:
15 16	Amend Afficie X of the Constitution of Virginia by adding a section numbered 0-A as follows. ARTICLE X
17	TAXATION AND FINANCE
18	Section 6-A. Property tax exemption for certain veterans.
19	Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 6, the General Assembly shall by general law exempt from
20	taxation the real property, including the joint real property of husband and wife, of any veteran who
21	has been determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor agency
22	pursuant to federal law to have a service-connected, permanent, and one hundred percent total
23	disability, and who occupies the real property as his or her principal place of residence. The General
24	Assembly may also provide this exemption from taxation for real property owned by the surviving
25	spouse of a veteran who was eligible for the exemption provided in this section, so long as the surviving
26	spouse does not remarry and continues to occupy the real property as his or her principal place of
