WHEREAS, acting on her passion for freedom of the press, Judith Hines was instrumental in the founding of the Newseum, a museum about news, in 1996 and has been involved for years with the Freedom Forum, an organization dedicated to freedom of the press and free speech; and

WHEREAS, Judith Hines touches many lives at Saint James United Church of Christ as an active participant in the church's many missions in the community; and

WHEREAS, a remarkable woman with boundless energy, Judith Hines knows that she is only able to serve in such a significant way because of the love and support of her family—her devoted husband, Taylor, who plays no small role in his wife's projects, and her two children, Nancy Hines of Leesburg and David Hines of California; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend Judith Hines on her well-deserved recognition as the *Loudoun Times-Mirror* 2008 Citizen of the Year; and, be it
