8 judge for the Fifteenth Judicial District of Virginia; and

9 WHEREAS, George Mason graduated with a bachelor's degree from the University of Virginia,
10 earned a law degree from The College of William and Mary's Marshall-Wythe School of Law, and was
11 admitted to the Virginia State Bar in 1975; and

WHEREAS, George Mason is a direct descendant of the Virginia patriot, George Mason (1725 1792), and he is extremely proud to carry on a family tradition of practicing law as did his father and
grandfather before him; and

WHEREAS, a man of integrity, honesty, and considerable legal knowledge, George Mason engaged
in the private practice of law in his hometown of Colonial Beach for many years and has been an active
member of his community, giving his time and expertise as a board member for many professional,
civic, and government organizations; and

19 WHEREAS, Judge Mason was appointed to the circuit court bench for the Fifteenth Judicial District
20 of Virginia in 2005, after serving two years as a General District judge hearing cases in the Northern
21 Neck and Essex County; and

WHEREAS, Judge Mason is an admired and exceptional jurist, who has presided over cases in
 Spotsylvania, Hanover, and Westmoreland Counties with great fairness, skill, and compassion; now,
