WHEREAS, an inspiration to all of her fellow educators, Carole Lopez is greatly admired for her selflessness, incredible resilience, and sincere commitment to her students and the importance of their education; she came out of medical retirement to work at Washington-Lee High School for several years before again retiring due to illness; and

WHEREAS, throughout her career, Carole Lopez's compassion, dedication, and thoughtful guidance touched the lives of thousands of students; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend and congratulate Carole Lopez on her outstanding career as a guidance counselor at Washington-Lee High School; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution for presentation to Carole Lopez as an expression of the General Assembly's gratitude for her commitment to the students and parents of Arlington and best wishes for a happy and restful retirement.
