10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 19.2-264.3:1.3 as follows:
12	§ 19.2-264.3:1.3. Expert assistance for indigent defendants in capital cases.
13	A. In any case in which the defendant (i) is charged with a capital offense and (ii) is found by the
14	court to be financially unable to pay for expert assistance, the defendant or his attorney may move for
15	the appointment of a qualified expert to assist in the preparation of the defendant's defense. The motion
16	shall be heard ex parte as soon as practicable and, after a hearing upon the motion, the court may
17	order the appointment of a qualified expert. Any expert appointed pursuant to this subsection shall be
18	compensated in accordance with § 19.2-332.
19 20	B. Any report, analysis, evaluation, or other work product made by an expert appointed pursuant to
20 21	subsection A shall be subject to attorney-client privilege. Nothing in this subsection shall affect the duty of the defendant to adequately and fully provide discovery as provided under Rule 3A:11 of the Rules of
22	the Supreme Court.
