2 *An Act to designate certain highway segments as the "Wilderness Road: Virginia's Heritage Migration*

5 Approved

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. § 1.** *That the following route is hereby designated the "Wilderness Road: Virginia's Heritage*
8 *Migration Route": U.S. Route 11 from Winchester to Bristol, then connecting with the Daniel Boone*
9 *Wilderness Trail in Scott County and continuing west on U.S. Routes 58 and 23, ending at Cumberland*
10 *Gap National Heritage Park in Lee County where it intersects with the Kentucky Wilderness Road*
11 *Heritage Highway, and the Fincastle Turnpike and the Carolina Road spurs that branch off in Botetourt*
12 *County. These roads, which went by a variety of names depending upon their location, collectively drew*
13 *thousands of settlers southwestward from Pennsylvania and Maryland into and through the Great Valley*
14 *of Virginia and into the wilderness of the American frontier. This designation shall not affect any other*
15 *designation heretofore (including the Great Wagon Road, the Irish Tract, the Peaked Mountain, and the*
16 *Great Philadelphia Road) or hereafter applied to this route or any portions thereof.*

17 **2. That the provisions of subdivision (4) of § 33.1-12 of the Code of Virginia relating to placing**
18 **and maintaining appropriate signs and the payment of costs associated therewith shall not apply to**
19 **this act.**
