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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 38.2-5008.1 as follows:
12	§ 38.2-5008.1. Right to confront and cross-examine evidence; right to de novo review.
13	A. Upon timely motion, all parties to a claim under this chapter shall have the right to confront and
14	cross-examine evidence filed in the claim or offered for admission into evidence. In pursuing that right,
15	a party shall not be precluded from conducting depositions by oral examination or cross-examination at
16	a hearing of any witnesses from whom evidence is elicited.
17	B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any claimant who timely filed a claim and after
18	timely seeking and being denied an opportunity to conduct depositions by oral examination or otherwise
19	being denied the opportunity to confront or cross-examine evidence presented in opposition of such
20	claim, was denied an award of benefits, shall have the right to have the determination against that
21	claim vacated and the claim redetermined de novo by filing a petition with the Commission seeking to
22	have the determination against that claim vacated. Such petition shall be filed on or before July 1,
23	2011, and may be filed regardless of whether or not the party has filed for review of the denied claim.
24	Upon receipt of such a petition, the Commission shall vacate the order denying benefits previously
25	entered, place the matter on the hearing docket, administer the claim and make a determination on the
26	merits of the claim de novo, as if no previous filing, hearing, determination, review or dismissal of that
27	alaim had occurred around that the Commission shall not be required to request the namel of physician
