- "Criminal street gang" shall be as defined in § 18.2-46.1. "Enterprise" includes any of the following: sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, business 11 12 trust, criminal street gang; or other group of three or more individuals associated for the purpose of
- 13 criminal activity.
- 14 "Proceeds" shall be as defined in § 18.2-246.2.

30 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or

- 31 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and is \$0 for 32
- 33 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
