10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 63.2-505.2. Eligibility for TANF and food stamps; drug-related felonies.
13	A person who is otherwise eligible to receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or
14	food stamp benefits shall be exempt from the application of section 115(a) of the Personal
15	Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied
16	such assistance solely because he has been convicted of a felony offense of possession of a controlled
17	substance in violation of § 18.2-250, provided such person is complying with, or has already complied
18	with, all obligations imposed by the criminal court, is actively engaged in or has completed a substance

abuse treatment program, participates in periodic drug screenings, and any other obligations asdetermined by the Department.
