8 9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 28.2-705 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 28.2-705. License restrictions; exemption; penalty.
12	A. It is unlawful to:
13	1. Take crabs with a rake which is pulled or pushed by a boat;
14	2. Use a crab pot which has a mesh less than 1 1/2 inches, unless a different mesh size is
15	promulgated pursuant to subsection B of § 28.2-701;
16	3. Place food, except as may be provided for in regulations of the Commission, for adult male
17	(jimmy) crabs in a peeler pot. A peeler pot is exempt from mesh size limitations, unless a peeler pot
18	
	mesh size is promulgated pursuant to subsection B of § 28.2-701;
19 20	4. Use a boat when buying crabs which is also used to take or catch hard crabs with dredges, when
20	the Commission has limited the taking of crabs under § 28.2-713; and
21	5. Take crabs from a crab pot unless authorized by the owner licensed and identified pursuant to

    B. Any person who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
