10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 15.2-2283 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 15.2-2283. Purpose of zoning ordinances.
12	Zoning ordinances shall be for the general purpose of promoting the health, safety or general welfare
14	of the public and of further accomplishing the objectives of § 15.2-2200. To these ends, such ordinances
15	shall be designed to give reasonable consideration to each of the following purposes, where applicable:
16	(i) to provide for adequate light, air, convenience of access, and safety from fire, flood, crime and other
17	dangers; (ii) to reduce or prevent congestion in the public streets; (iii) to facilitate the creation of a
18	convenient, attractive and harmonious community; (iv) to facilitate the provision of adequate police and
19	fire protection, disaster evacuation, civil defense, transportation, water, sewerage, flood protection,
20	schools, parks, forests, playgrounds, recreational facilities, airports and other public requirements; (v) to
21	protect against destruction of or encroachment upon historic areas; (vi) to protect against one or more of
22	the following: overcrowding of land, undue density of population in relation to the community facilities
23	existing or available, obstruction of light and air, danger and congestion in travel and transportation, or
24	loss of life, health, or property from fire, flood, panic or other dangers; (vii) to encourage economic
25	development activities that provide desirable employment and enlarge the tax base; (viii) to provide for
26 27	the preservation of agricultural and forestal lands and other lands of significance for the protection of
28	the natural environment; (ix) to [<i>protect the land, water, and air from harmful discharges, emissions, and other releases conserve natural and environmental resources</i>]; (x) to protect approach slopes and
20 29	other safety areas of licensed airports, including United States government and military air facilities; (x)
3 0	(xi) to promote the creation and preservation of affordable housing suitable for meeting the current and
31	future needs of the locality as well as a reasonable proportion of the current and future needs of the
32	planning district within which the locality is situated; and $\frac{(xi)}{(xii)}$ to provide reasonable protection
33	against encroachment upon military bases, military installations, and military airports and their adjacent
34	safety areas, excluding armories operated by the Virginia National Guard. Such ordinance may also
35	include reasonable provisions, not inconsistent with applicable state water quality standards, to protect
36	surface water and ground water as defined in § 62.1-255.
