12	§ 19.2-11.02. Prohibition on investigating victim and witness's immigration status.
13	When a person reports to law enforcement that he was a victim of or witness to a crime, neither the
14	law-enforcement officer nor any other public officer or official may question the person as to whether
15	the person making the report or any member of his immediate family, other than a member whom the
16	reporter identifies as the alleged perpetrator of a crime, is a citizen or is otherwise lawfully present in
17	the United States and the law-enforcement officer or other public officer or official may not investigate

18 or cause to be investigated the immigration or legal status of such victim or witness.
