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11	WHEREAS, as of June 30, 2008, the disposal facility in Barnwell, South Carolina, will no longer
12	accept certain classes of low-level radioactive waste from Virginia; and
13	WHEREAS, the Barnwell facility is currently the only facility accepting this waste for disposal; and
14	WHEREAS, due to environmental and health concerns, disposal of this low-level radioactive waste is
15	preferable to long-term storage; and
16	WHEREAS, Virginia has less than a year to find alternative methods of dealing with this waste;
17	now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Department of Health be
19 20	requested to study long-term options for the disposal of low-level radioactive waste. In conducting its study, the Department shall, in consultation with the Department of Environmental
20 21	Quality, investigate alternative methods of disposal or storage of Class B and Class C low-level
22	radioactive waste, taking into consideration both industry needs and public health and safety concerns.
$\bar{23}$	Technical assistance shall be provided to the Department by the Department of Environmental
24	Quality. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department for this study,
25	upon request.
26	The Department of Health shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2008, and shall submit to
27	the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings and
28	recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and report
29 20	shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
30 21	the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the 2009 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.
