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10	WHEREAS, the Virginia Unclaimed Property Act (§ 55-210.1 et seq.) protects unclaimed property
11	until such property is returned to the rightful owner; and
12	WHERÊAŜ, unclaimed property is money or intangible property owed to an individual or business
13	that has been held for an extended period of time with no owner contact and a good faith effort has
14	been made to locate the owner; and
15	WHEREAS, businesses and other organizations are required by law to review their records each year
16 17	to determine if they hold any funds, securities or other property that have remained unclaimed; and WHEREAS, these businesses are also required to file an annual report on the unclaimed property and
18	to transfer the property to the state; and
19	WHEREAS, the Department of Treasury, Division of Unclaimed Property acts as custodian of the
20	property and administers a program to locate the rightful owners; and
21	WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding the cost to businesses of complying with the annual
22	reporting requirement; and
23	WHEREAS, establishment of a minimum threshold amount for reporting and transferring unclaimed
24	property to the state would serve to alleviate these costs; and
25 26	WHEREAS, there is a need to review the feasibility of establishing a minimum threshold amount for
20 27	reporting and transferring unclaimed property to the state; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Department of Treasury be
28	requested to study reporting requirements established by the Virginia Unclaimed Property Act.
29	In conducting its study, the Department shall review the feasibility of establishing a minimum
30	threshold amount for reporting and transferring unclaimed property to the state.
31	The Department shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2008, and shall submit to the
32	Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings and
33	recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and report
34	shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
35 36	the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the 2009 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.
