**4. Title:**        Notification of mental health treatment to parents of a dependent student.

**5. Summary:** Requires the board of visitors or other governing board of any public institution of higher education to establish policies and procedures requiring the notification of a parent of a dependent student when such student receives mental health treatment at the institution's student health or counseling center and it has been determined that the student may cause serious bodily harm to himself or others.

**6. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate, see Item 8.

**7. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill requires that the boards of visitors at each public college or university establish policies and procedures for parental notification of a dependent student when the school determines a student may have suicidal tendencies or may be an imminent danger to others. The cost to the schools to prepare written policies should be minimal.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** All state colleges and universities.
