4. Title: Board for Contractors; elevator mechanics

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the Board for Contractors to issue temporary certifications to elevator mechanics in the event of a shortage of elevator mechanics where a licensed contractor demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Board that there is such a shortage. The bill contains technical amendments.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation anticipates that this bill will not have a significant fiscal impact on their agency.
