4. Title: Professional engineering of onsite treatment works

5. Summary: Authorizes the Board of Health, the Commissioner of Health, and the Department of Health to accept treatment works designs from individuals licensed as professional engineers. The bill establishes the procedure for submission and review of designs by an engineering design review panel.

6. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact of this legislation upon the Department of Health cannot be determined at this time because the number of permit applications expected to be received by the agency is unknown, along with the expected number of applications that would be denied and therefore have to be reviewed by the panel. Although the total fiscal impact is unknown, the Department expects to absorb any expenditure related to the implementation of this bill.
