Currently, attorneys for the Commonwealth are charged with the responsibility of representing districts and district directors.

- 8. Fiscal Implications:** The Office of the Attorney General estimates it will need one additional attorney to adequately represent the Soil and Water Conservation Districts in suits or actions brought by the districts or district directors due to the time involved with the actions.

The costs are based on an entry level attorney and necessary support costs:

The OAG reports that if a budget amendment is not provided, it will need to charge the districts for any services provided.

No offsetting dollar savings were estimated for the Commonwealth's Attorneys but their workload throughout the Commonwealth should be reduced by at least one full-time equivalent position.
