5. Summary: The bill authorizes the Director of the Department of Conservation and Recreation to lease private residential properties that are near state parks and then subsequently sublease these properties to state park employees.

8. Fiscal Implications: Although there will be additional costs to lease properties, the cost of staff residences is built into the agency's operating budget. The ability to lease private residential properties that are near state parks may reduce the need for other arrangements, such as overtime pay or private security, to provide overnight public safety at state parks.
