4. Title: Contractors on school property.

5. Summary: Provides that a contractor or his employee may request a waiver from disqualification of providing services because of a felony conviction under certain conditions. The felony conviction must have occurred at least five years prior to the date of the waiver request, and the felony must not have involved: (i) the sexual molestation or physical or sexual abuse or rape of a child; (ii) any crime against the person under Chapter 4 of Title 18.2; or (iii) health and safety under Articles 1 or 1.1 of Chapter 7 of Title 18.2.
